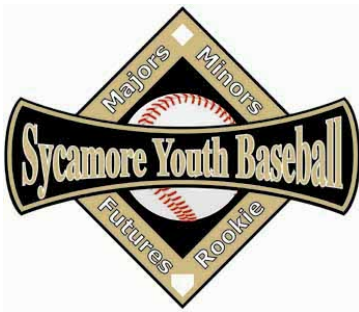

## **"IN HOUSE" / LEAGUE ALL STAR TEAMS ONLY**

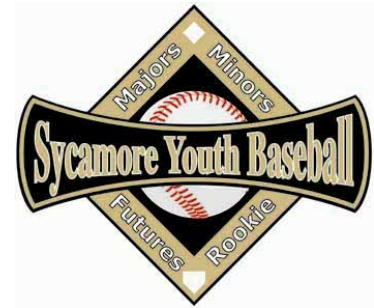
Definition: "In House" or League All Star Team is a team which a team has participated as a team in any organized travel league or a travel program outside of their local city leagues.

# TEAMS

The Sycamore Summer Classic Tournament was developed for In House All Star Teams or League All Star Teams to compete at a higher level of play in a fun but competitive baseball environment. To maintain this level of play and keep the playing field a level as possible. Players that have played on a team that has played in three or more tournaments or any other organized league may not be rostered with a team playing in the Sycamore Summer Classic Tournament.

# PLAYER AGES

The tournament will follow a birthday cut off that is consistent with most local area leagues. League placement for players shall be determined by the grade the child is in the spring of the current season. Age shall be calculated as the age of the child as of April 1st of the year in which the games are played.

You will not be required to provide a Birth Certificate for a player except in the event there is protest. Coaches unable to provide a Birth Certificate if a protest has been issued will be forced to forfeit the game being protested. The Final Tournament Roster form will require that a Birth Date be listed for each player.

# INSURANCE

Prior to your first game, we will require a copy of your insurance certificate. Failure to provide SYB with the certificate by the above date will forfeit your spot in the tournament and will be given to a waiting list team. Please send the certificate to:

Your team will not be able to participate in any scheduled games during the tournament if you have not sent in your Insurance Certificate.

The fields are located on the West side of Sycamore just off of Route 64 on Airport Road.

## ARRIVING FOR YOUR FIRST GAME

When you pull into the facility, the Futures & Minor League (8U & 10U) Fields are to the Right and the Major League (12U) Fields are straight ahead behind the High School Baseball Field. Parking is a first come, first serve basis.

Please plan to be at your first scheduled game no later than 1 hour ahead of time. You must turn in your Roster either before your first game or during check in at the Check in table. You will not be required to provide a birth certificate at check in but will be required to have them on file in the event there is a protest filed or if another team files an Age Protest.

You will be required to furnish SYB a contact phone number (Preferably a Cell Phone) in the event of a rain out. Rain Out days during the week have been set a side to make up weekday games but there are no rain out days during weekend play. The phone number will also be used to contact your team for Championship Sunday game times.

## TOURNAMENT FORMAT

This will be a “Pool Play” Tournament in order to qualify for the Single Elimination Championship brackets.

There will be a Championship Game as well as a Third Place Game on Sunday afternoon for all divisions.

Each team will be guaranteed at least 3 games during the tournament.

Advancement to the Semi Final brackets will be determined by the following criteria in the following order:

1. Win / Loss Record
2. Head to Head Play results
3. Least runs given up after pool play
4. Most runs scored after pool play

Individual trophies will be given for the Tournament Championship Game teams. Medals will be given to the teams achieving third and fourth place in the tournament.

# UMPIRES

Patched Umpires will be used for each game in both levels. Each Umpire has gone through the required training to achieve Patched status and has umpired for at least 2 seasons.

## ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES AND RULES

- The use of tobacco products in the dugouts or on the playing fields is strictly prohibited.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages at any of the field complexes is strictly prohibited.
- Any Manager, Coach, Player or Parent may be ejected from the game for using foul, abusive language or gestures to any Manager, Coach, Player or Umpire. If ejected, such persons will be required to leave the complex immediately and will not be allowed to attend the next team's game.
- Failure to cooperate with the Code of Conduct Rules (Located on the SYB Website) can result in the forfeiture of the current game and Tournament elimination. Team Managers are responsible for the behavior of the coaches, players and parents and will be held accountable for their actions.
- The Umpire(s) control the game once the teams occupy their respective dugouts.
- Food will be served at the complex, due to this there are potential sanitary issues so we ask that you NOT bring pets to the game. Due to the hot weather at this time of year, SYB strongly suggests that pets not be left inside vehicles being parked at the Tournament.
- If anyone attending the Tournament becomes ill or injured, please contact one of the Tournament Coordinators for assistance immediately.
- Each team is responsible for picking up their dugout and fan areas after the conclusion of each game. Failure to do so will result in a team warning on the first offense and a possible game forfeiture on the second offense.
- There is a batting cage located on the South side of the Complex for teams to use. SYB asks that each team be courteous to other teams and tournament coordinators when using the cage area.
- Games during the week will be strictly enforced on starting times of 6:00 pm for Futures (8U) and Minors (10U). For Major League, game times are strictly enforced for starting times of 5:30 pm and 7:30 pm during the weekdays
